REQUIRED STATEMENTS

- a. The Offeror will participate fully with other VFHY contractors as requested to coordinate efforts within its comprehensive marketing initiative.
- b. The Offeror's primary mission, the primary mission of collaborating agencies, and/or the primary mission of other agencies funding a portion of the proposed program do not conflict with VFHY's mission.
- c. The Offeror certifies it will comply with Section 32.1-361 of the Code of Virginia that requires contractors to establish and maintain policies restricting or preventing tobacco use by minors. The Offeror expressly acknowledges that Virginia law requires the establishment and maintenance of such policies by each Contractor as a condition precedent to the release of payment of any money from the Virginia Tobacco Settlement Fund to such Contractor.
- d. The Offeror certifies it has reviewed any addenda issued related to the RFP as posted on the VFHY website and/or eVA.
